

**WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL
ORDINANCE NO. 2025-07**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING REDUNDANT SECTION 50.42(A) OF THE
WHITELAND TOWN CODE CONCERNING SEWER CONNECTION FEES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Whiteland (the “Town”) owns and operates a municipal sewage works system and charges users for connecting or tapping on to the system; and

WHEREAS, both Sections 50.42(A) and 50.87(D) of the Whiteland Town Code (the “Town Code”) contain provisions for connection or tap fees that are redundant and inconsistent with each other; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland (the “Town Council”) has determined that the inconsistencies in the Town Code for connection or tap fees should be corrected and clarified through the repeal of Section 50.42(A) of the Town Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein, are made findings and determinations of the Town Council, and are made an operative part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Section 50.42 of the Whiteland Town Code is hereby revised to delete Section 50.42(A) and to hereafter read as follows:

§ 50.42 COSTS AND EXPENSES OF INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWER

In addition to the connection fees provided in this chapter, the owner of any building or platted lot is required to connect to the sanitary sewer system of the town and shall pay all costs of the construction of the necessary local or lateral services adequate to serve such property and all other costs of connection including, without limitation, excavation, backfill, and pavement replacement.

Section 3. All prior ordinance provisions in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and its invalidity shall have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.



The provisions set forth in this ordinance shall become and remain in full force and effect (until their repeal by ordinance, to the extent permitted by law) on the date of adoption of this ordinance as evidenced by the signature of the executive as prescribed by Indiana Code 36-5-2-10, subject to publication of this ordinance to the extent required by law.


