

**WHITELAND TOWN COUNCIL
ORDINANCE NO. 2025-09**

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA
(FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BONDS)**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Whiteland, Indiana (the “Town”), acting as the Board of Fire Trustees (the “Board”) of the Whiteland Fire Protection District (the “District”), through its status as successor by merger to the District, has determined to (i) acquire certain fire protection vehicles and equipment, including, but not limited to, a new fire engine, a new ladder truck and other emergency vehicles and related equipment, and (ii) repair and upgrade existing vehicles and equipment, all for use within the District ((i) and (ii) collectively, the “Project”), as described in an ordinance adopted by the Town Council of the Town (the “Council”) on June 10, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the estimated cost of the Project, and the incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with the Project, including reimbursement to the Town, capitalized interest, if necessary, and with the issuance of bonds, to finance the Project, will be in an amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred and Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$1,460,000); and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to issue fire protection district bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred and Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$1,460,000) to fund the costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, there has been published a notice of a public hearing on the appropriation of the proceeds of the fire protection district bonds, to be held on this date; the hearing has been held; and the Council has considered the evidence presented at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Council now finds that the Town does not have sufficient funds available or provided for in the existing budget and tax levy to fund the cost of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITELAND, INDIANA, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE BOARD OF FIRE TRUSTEES OF THE WHITELAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, THAT:

Section 1. The Council finds that all proceedings required before appropriation of the proceeds of the fire protection district bonds have been accomplished and completed.


Section 2. For the purpose of paying the cost of the Project, including reimbursement to the Town, capitalized interest, if necessary, and incidental expenses necessary to be incurred with the Project and the fire protection district bonds, an amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred and Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$1,460,000) shall be appropriated from the proceeds of the fire protection district bonds.

Section 3. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to submit and certify this ordinance and the related proceedings to the Department of Local Government Finance in accordance with Indiana Code 6-1.1-18-5.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

DULY PASSED AND FINALLY ADOPTED on the 10th day of June, 2025, by a vote of 4 in favor and 0 against.




